

GENERAL RULES

Trailer check-in will be in front of the Expo Center – do not unload your horse(s) until your original Coggins papers have been checked and you receive a document giving you permission to unload and proceed with the registration/stalling process. If you do not have your original Coggins papers, you will not be allowed to show. No one will be allowed to check-in or have stalls available until after 4:00 p.m. on Friday.

A copy of the negative Coggins test must be sent with the entry form. Coggins tests are valid for 12 months; if you plan to get one Coggins test, be sure you get it so it will be valid from April – September. You must have the original negative Coggins with the horse at the District and State 4-H Horse Show.

Information concerning eligibility and rules for classes are in the Rules and Regulations for Oklahoma 4-H Horse Shows revised January 2009. These rules are available at your local County Extension office or you can download them from the State 4-H Website:
