

Brush Control - Individual Plants

Low volume basal treatment of brush is a selective and cost effective method of control.

Basal treatment consists of mixing one part Remedy (herbicide) with three parts diesel fuel, then spraying this mixture on the lower twelve inches of the stem. Spray until the stem is wet but not to the point of run-off. Basal spray is very effective on small hardwoods, less than 2" in diameter. July to October is the best time to basal treat, and March to April is the worst.
