

## Cattail Control

Cattails can become a problem around the banks of ponds limiting access to the shoreline. Cattails are relatively easy to control with herbicide 2,4-D (38.9% ae liquid) when cattails are approximately three foot tall and actively growing. It is best to treat before seed spikes are formed. Approximate dose to use is 4 ounces of herbicide per gallon of water. Follow all label instructions.
