

OK Steer Feedout

Cow-calf operators who wish to know how their calves perform when in the feedlot can find out by becoming involved in the OK Steer Feedout. This event, sponsored by the Oklahoma State University Cooperative Extension has producers enter five head of spring or fall born calves in a feedout where all performance data, including carcass performance, will be gathered.

Fall born calves need to be nominated by August 8 and delivered to the feedlot in Guthrie, Oklahoma on August 15.

Spring born calves need to be nominated by October 31 and delivered to the yard on November 7.

All calves must be weaned on arrival.
